NOTICE TO REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF ESSEX:

There is a local Special Election on Monday, November 21st, 2011

Polls will be open from 12:00pm-8:00pm at Memorial Fire Station, 24 Martin Street, to vote to approve the purchase of a building to move the current Town Offices.

Please note: the election will be from 12pm-8pm only. If you are unable to make it to the polls during the open hours you may vote by Absentee Ballot.

Absentee Ballot Process:

An application to vote by absentee ballot must be made in writing by 5:00pm on Thursday, November 17th. This “application” can either be on a form prescribed by the Secretary of State OR a signed request from the voter personally. [Application forms are available online by clicking here.](#)

Please ensure the absentee request includes a signature from the voter and ballot delivery instructions.

This request may be delivered in hand, by mail (30 Martin Street), by email (cwright@essexma.org), or by fax (978-768-2505).

One may vote Absentee in person at Town Hall Monday-Thursday from 7:30am-3:30pm OR may request that the ballot be mailed.

All absentee ballots must be received by the 8pm on November 21st, even if they are mailed from outside the United States.

If you have not yet registered to vote in Essex you will not be eligible to vote in this Special Election. The deadline for voter registration is 20 days before an election.
