

Essex Economic Development Initiative - Goals

- Through MAPC's Technical Assistance Program, we will be working with Essex to create an Economic Development Action Plan (EDAP) for the Town.
- This plan will guide the town's goals and priorities for the next 5-10 years.
- Additionally, strong community participation will be critical in ensuring that any plan that is developed will be used and adhered to by the town.
- This will expand upon the 2015 Strategic Plan, the 2016 Essex Downtown Parking Strategy, and the 2018 Essex Village Center Zoning Study.
- We well also by conducting a market assessment of the town and region to identify competitive advantages for Essex, engaging the community to establish an economic development vision for the town, and work with the Economic Development Committee (EDC) to create townwide economic development strategies.




Essex Economic Development Initiative - Deliverables

- 2. Development of a townwide vision for economic development with goals and strategies.

- 4. Identify best practices amongst public/private initiatives as well as those in need of improvement.






Essex Economic Development Initiative – Tax Revenue by Source








