Zoning Bylaw Recodification

With the assistance of the Metropolitan Area Planning Council (MAPC), the Town of Essex has undertaken a multi-phased project to recodify and update its Zoning Bylaw.

In **Phase I** (completed June 2022), MAPC conducted a review of Essex's Zoning Bylaw and produced a Zoning Diagnostic Report.

The report summarized key findings and observations of the Town's existing zoning regulations and land use practices, incorporating considerable community input, and offered recommendations for potential Zoning Bylaw amendments.

Phase II goals include:

- Reorganization of the existing bylaw into a more intuitive layout that is easier for users to navigate.
- Drafting a Community Vision for future zoning regulations and potential zoning districts to guide the Town's growth in a sustainable and responsible manner and reflect our community values.
