<b>Metal</b>	Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids Non-deposit beverage cans Rinse clean, may flatten, labels may stay on	No cans containing aerosol or hazardous material.
<b>Paper</b>	Newspaper/inserts (including glossy newsprint) Magazines, Junk mail, catalogs, phonebooks	No soiled paper, pizza boxes, or plastic bags, no waxed paper, or Cardboard
<b>Plastic</b>	Plastic containers #1-#7 can now be recycled Empty and rinse clean	no plastic bags
<b>Cardboard</b>	Corrugated cardboard – please flatten	

**Misc. items**    \$15.00 fee for TV’s, and Monitors  
                       \$15.00 fee for large bulk items (Stoves, oven, dishwashers, hot water tanks, furnaces  
                       mattresses, box springs, couches, love seats, recliners, tables, large toys, large rugs etc)  
                       \$20.00 fee for any item with Freon (Freezers, refrigerators, dehumidifiers, AC’s, water  
                       coolers etc)
