

Essex Conservation Commission

April 19, 1994 - Minutes

Present: David Folsom, Chairman, Canan Hewson, Edith Messersmith, Edwin Perkins, Thomas Prentiss.

Meeting called to order at 8:00 p.m.

A request was made to the Board by Kevin Street for an extension to his Order of Conditions, D.E.P. File #21-218, for work at 46 Wood Drive.

Perkins moved to grant an Extension Permit to Kevin Street for Order of Conditions D.E.P. File #21-218 for work at 46 Wood Drive, seconded by Prentiss, with the Board voting unanimously in favor.

Ted Guldmond, Ralston Drive, met with the Board to discuss the construction of a second floor to his dwelling and for the addition of a studio. The studio will be 70 feet from the wetlands. Guldmond was given an Abbreviated Notice of Intent to file.

A continuation of a public hearing was held under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, M.G.L. Chapter 131, Section 40, on a Notice of Intent filed by Charles Filias covering maintenance and extension of an existing floating pier, to include driving of 8 piles and dredging of the area near the pier at 138 Main Street.


There was no representation for the applicant at the continuation.

Perkins moved that if John Dick, Hancock Survey Associates, requests a continuation of the public hearing, it be continued until May 10, 1994, at 8:00 p.m, seconded by Prentiss, with the Board voting unanimously in favor.

The Board reviewed the correspondence.

Perkins moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Messersmith, with the Board voting unanimously in favor. Meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
