• Title 5 Inspection Reports

130 Conomo Point Road, Map 108, Lot 65, McKenzie: Dr. Driscoll entertained a motion for the Board to sign and send a letter to McKenzie, 130 Conomo Point Road, stating that the Board is in agreement with the determination of inspector John Duncan that the system passed the official Title 5 inspection conducted on September 4, 2019. Ms. Roderick so moved. **Vote: All in Favor.**

• Septic Plan Reviews

Prior to issuance of the Certificate of Compliance for the septic system and the Certificate of Occupancy for the dwelling, a total room count must be conducted to ensure the existing daily flow corresponds with the design flow as outlined in the septic design and building plans. Ms. Roderick so moved. **Vote: All in Favor.**

Water Supply Certificate, 208 Southern Avenue, Nally: Dr. Driscoll entertain a motion for the Board to sign the well water certificate, dated June 26, 2018, for Nally, 208 Southern Avenue. The well water meets all parameters for drinking water as outlined in state and federal regulations. Ms. Roderick so moved. **Vote: All in Favor.**

2019 Mobile Food Permit #4, The American BBQ, Rowley, MA & 2020 Mobile Food Permit #1, The American BBQ, Rowley, MA.

Dr. Driscoll entertained a motion for the Board to sign and send letters to Essex licensed food retailers, explaining what is in the guidance document recently received by Local Boards of Health, specifically that CBD is an active ingredient in FDA-approved drugs and because it is not an approved ingredient under the FDA food code, requesting removal of any food products containing CBD from their shelves. Ms. Roderick so moved. **Vote: All in Favor.**

Discussion: Essex Tobacco Regulations Revision. Because vaping is an eminent health hazard, Dr. Driscoll asked Ms. Kirchner the advisability of bringing forward the revision of the Essex Tobacco Regulations Revision public meeting and vote to a date before the Board agreed upon January 2020 timeline. Ms. Kirchner will consult with Essex's Legal Counsel for direction.
